A pivotal part of being a recruiter is knowing the area where your families live. For a recruiter to make a true impact with ID&R, the recruiters need to know the employment industries that reside in their school districts.

Below I listed a few items that a recruiter needs to know about their area.

Knowing your District

- Knowledge of the agricultural and fishing industry
 - what kind of jobs make up the migrant activity?
 - who are the migrant employers?

- Knowledge of the Migrant Cycle
 - when do migrants arrive in the area?
 - how long do they stay?

- Knowledge of housing for migrant workers.
- Knowledge of agencies that provide services to migrant families.

These are just a few areas that a recruiter needs to know before they conduct ID&R in their districts.
